Agenda:

- We watched the video of NRG presentation to Council from Nov. 14th while we ate pizza.
- LAHS sign action steps reports included the following:
 1. Grant Janecky emailed his winning logo to all youth team members after our December 4th meeting.
 2. Ashley did talk with her dad about making a drawing for our sign. Lori gave her a copy of Grant's logo for her dad to use in making his sample design.
 3. Lori contacted Roger Waterman, who said that he will help to sponsor the sign. He is not committing to any dollar amount yet, and wants us to contact him when we have more specifics. Interestingly, he was one of the original group of seniors who did the current LAHS sign many years ago! He didn't say how many!
 4. Barb Marcille gave Lori the file from last year's efforts. The sign criteria are listed below.
 5. Ashley and Brenna talked briefly with Ms. Saccaro. She gave the "go ahead."
 6. Ben was unable to get any information from the sign company in SF.
 7. A couple of us found some information on signs on the internet, but finding catalogs has been difficult. Sharon Stover made some attempts, also.
- The next sign action steps are as follows:
 1. Ashley will ask her dad to draw up a sample sign using Grant's logo
 2. Ben and Kory will contact Tom Littleton at the school district to find out exact procedures to follow.
 3. Craig will contact the county and Martha for additional information on procedures.
- **The next Sullivan trash pick up is scheduled for 3:30 PM on Wed., Jan. 17th. Craig will bring the bags and gloves. We are asking everyone to be there to help.**

We reviewed the sign design criteria from last year (thanks to Barb Marcille's notes):

- Design to incorporate LAHS colors and mascot name (Hilltoppers)
- Sign must meet design dimensions and restrictions
 1. Maximum sign final size is 75 square feet
 2. Maximum sign height is 20 feet
 3. Lettering must be a minimum of 8 inches tall
 4. No more than three lines of text
 5. Design can include changeable text, however no scrolling or flashing lights are permitted
 6. Sign will be positioned no closer than 15' from the road, and no closer than 50' from the driveway entrance to the LAHS parking lot
