Campus Beautification Update:

Action:

School Spirit Update:

Great response from tee shirt sales, and tremendous team work – Anna did an awesome job leading this effort! Becky Hardy was the vendor and shirts sold for \$10/each with \$4.50 profit made on each shirt. \$1,727 was paid for 314 shirts and \$1,950 generated to date -- **\$233 in profit!** Shirts styles were of each class (07, 08, 09, and 10), staff, and parents.

Action:

- Several tee shirts from seniors who ordered them have not been picked up. Anna to announce during school. If you know of a senior, get them to purchase their shirt.
- Staff shirts are needed; Anna to take orders and order through Becky.
- Continue selling shirts during Thursdays at school (Nik will get table set up for this week in A-wing), and later during basketball games. Anna and Jeremy heading this effort up, but could use additional volunteer help.
- Jeremy, Nik, Jessica, and Will volunteered to brainstorm some ideas for the basketball games; i.e., begin school spirit activities during JV basketball so that by the time the Varsity game has started, the crowd will be geared up. Suggested activities may include races, getting the high school band to play, and a dunk tank. Ideas will be presented at next team meeting.

Other Updates:

- Ropes Course. Team went over the waiver to participate deadline, appropriate clothing to wear, departure times/location, breakfast plans. A separate e-mail will be sent to participants. Plan to meet with Sean Hall on Sunday, October 8, from 7-9 p.m.
- Wellness Program. As long as some type of healthy food is offered, junk food can also be sold.
- Central Avenue Grill Dances. First dance is scheduled for Friday, October 20, following a home football game. There will be four dances held: October 20, December 1, March 2, and April 20th. Sharon reported that volunteer parents are needed to chaperone and that revenues generated from the dances will go towards the projects the leadership students are working on.
