

**Los Alamos County DWI Program**  
**Youth-Related Activities in Last Six Months**

- **Sticker Shock:** Volunteers from the Town Hall Meeting, JJAB, churches, and the DWI Planning Council have affixed stickers to multi-packs of alcohol for each of the 3-day weekends to warn against providing alcohol to minors.
- **Drug/alcohol policy:** Discussions are underway to consider changing the policies at LAHS regarding students participating in extra-curricular activities. The goals include providing a real deterrent effect, link school-police-courts-JPOs more effectively and identify potential substance abuse among students.
- **Newspaper ads:** Monthly ads have been run in the LA Monitor regarding a variety of alcohol-related issues.
- **Compliance Checks / Shoulder Taps:** In efforts to reduce access of alcohol to minors, two operations have been conducted in the last six months. This has resulted in a total of six arrests.
- **Checkpoints:** Several checkpoints have been conducted including one on Prom Night between Los Alamos and Santa Fe.
- **Theater ads:** Two ads are running at the Reel Deal Movie Theater. Recently the voice-overs were changed to be those of the School Prevention Specialist and the DWI Program Coordinator.
- **Family Solutions:** Beginning July 1, Family Strengths Network was contracted to implement the Family Solutions program designed to assist parents and families to prevent and address problems including substance abuse.
- **Youth Activities Center:** Funding was provided to supplement Summer activities at the Center in providing healthy, drug- and alcohol-free programs for Los Alamos young people.
- **e-CHUG Pilot:** Work is ongoing to assist in adapting this on-line self-assessment tool (currently used for college students) for use among high school students.

- **Senior Appreciation Night:** The DWI Program provided assistance in the planning of SAN, as well as supplementing the cost of the event.
- **Middle School Health Classes:** The DWI Program provided curriculum for the health classes at the LA Middle School.
- **Natural Helpers:** A follow-up meeting with the Natural Helpers was conducted near the end of the 2005-2006 school year, and meetings have now begun for the current school year.
