All our youth and adults are positively engaged in our society.

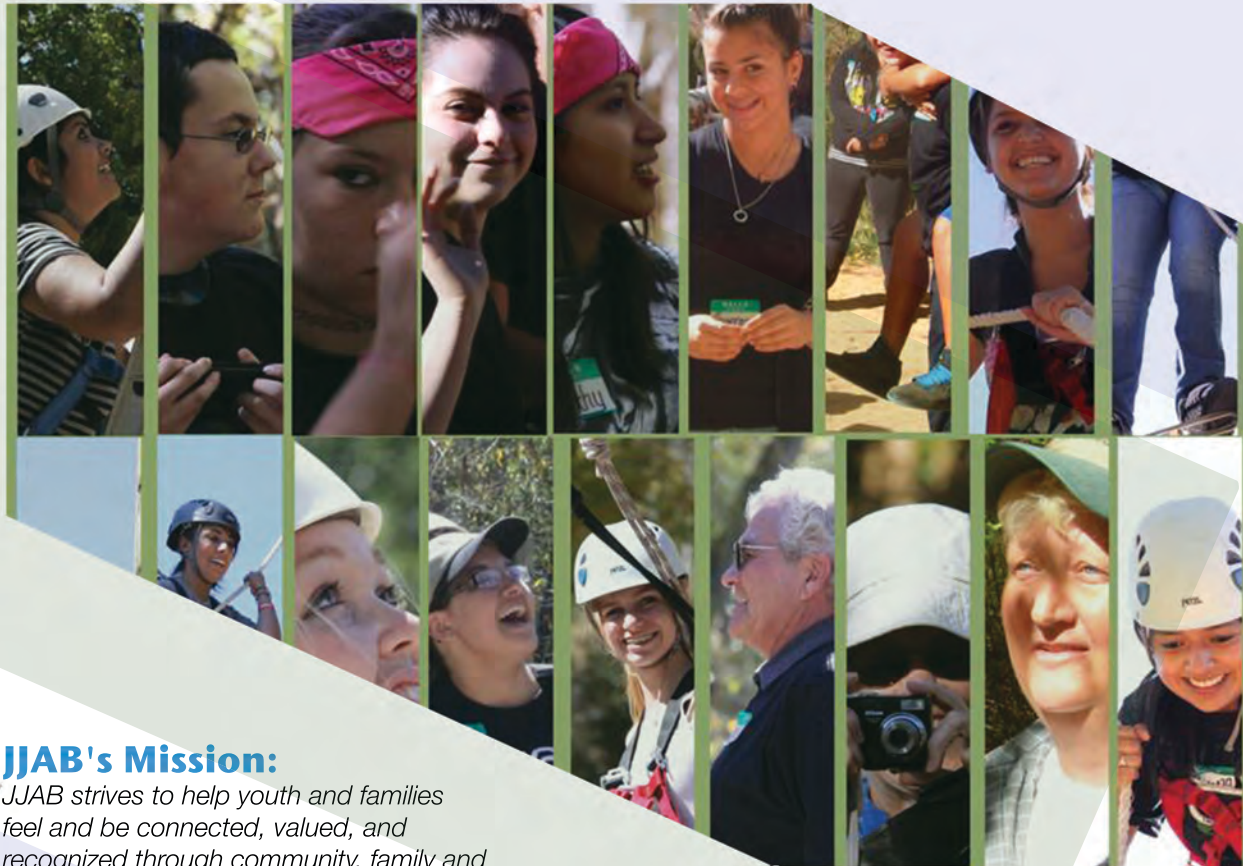
All programs are funded through Los Alamos County, Los Alamos Public Schools and a NM Children Youth and Families Department grant.
