- 1) Welcome – Alan Kirk, Chair -6:00 call to order
- 2) Introductions – All in attendance
- 3) Approval of Minutes – November minutes: Motion by Cary Skidmore, second by Brad Parker
- 4) Presentation JoAnne Tucker Ph.D. Healing Voices/Personal Stories Topics - Teen Dating Violence and Abuse, Healing Voices/Personal Stories, Cheyanne’s Story
  - a. Handouts given, discussed 1 in 3 women and 1 in 7 men, 1 in 5 women in high school are victims of domestic violence
  - b. Gave presentation in Raton in schools, would like to discuss in LAPS
  - c. DV red flags
  - d. How to empower victims; not to keep it a secret
- 5) RAPS video by UNM – Kristine Coblenz-video did not play, Kristine explained program
  - a. UNM will be coming up to train the 9 leaders, then will train 30 volunteers to deal with the YRRS data and RRAPS project
  - b. \$3000 for RRAPS now
  - c. Mindfulness training classes for counselors=Mind Up program, schools Aspen and Chamisa
  - d. Kristine’s office-coordinating mindfulness practice in schools,
  - e. Staff development-program development will it be coordinated by Kristine or coordinators directly to people

  - a. CYFD Funding Award FY18: State funding: Reduction of \$30,000 this year
  - b. County: No change as it is second year of two year cycle
  - c. School funding/United Way funding-MS YRA program

  - a. Alan described data collection system failure: no payment for 6 months, 17/21 continuum did not get paid.

  - a. William High Eagle Sandoval; October took over Boy’s Councils, 18 YRA clients
    - i. 8 kids for Life Skills, taught Life Skills the kids are requesting, talked about a “Plan B” for home based businesses
